Quick Summary:

There are 3 phases to this part of the game:

- 1) Take actions to find and attract potential players; mostly by sharing about your purpose. And sharing player success stories.
- 2) Engage with the people that you meet – mostly about purpose - to determine if they are a potential player.
- 3) If they are a potential player for you, invite them to explore the possibility of coaching with you for your next new player start date.

1) Take action, learn and SHARE

Recruiting is a lot of trial and error. Keep doing what you have found to be effective in the last game. AND keep trying new experiments. The key is to get up every day and get into the recruiting game with energy and curiosity. Take actions on your game plan, watch what happens and learn from your results. Let your fun coaching your players fuel your recruiting efforts!

THEN... SHARE what you have discovered about your game plan, your own abilities, your clarity of purpose, life and people...

The more you learn and the more you share the faster you will become a great recruiter!
